NOTICE UNDER THE BIOSECURITY ACT 1993

SECTION 131 - DECLARATION OF CONTROLLED AREA AND NOTICE OF MOVEMENT CONTROLS AND PROCEDURES IN RESPECT OF QUEENSLAND FRUIT FLY - *Bactrocera tryoni*

Commencement

1. This Declaration and Notice takes effect at 4:15 pm on 20 February 2019.


Controlled Area Declaration

2. Pursuant to section 131(2) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby declare that the area described in Schedule 1 ("the Controlled Area") is the area that is controlled in order to:—
 - a. Enable the limitation of the spread of *Bactrocera tryoni*, being an unwanted organism under the Biosecurity Act 1993;
 - b. Minimise the damage caused by *Bactrocera tryoni*;
 - c. Protect New Zealand from an incursion of *Bactrocera tryoni*;
 - d. Facilitate the access of New Zealand products to overseas markets; and
 - e. Monitor risks associated with the movement of *Bactrocera tryoni* from parts of New Zealand where the *Bactrocera tryoni* status is unknown.

Notice of Movement Controls

3. Under section 131(3)(a) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I hereby give notice that, except with the written permission of an inspector or authorised person appointed under s 103 of the Biosecurity Act 1993, and in compliance with any conditions imposed by an inspector or authorised person -
 - a. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A must not be moved outside Zone A; and
 - b. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in the Controlled Area Zone B must not be moved outside Zone B; and
 - c. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) that are in Controlled Area Zone A, and things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) that are in Controlled Area Zone B, must not be disposed of by putting out for collection by rubbish or recycling collectors.
4. For the avoidance of doubt:
 - a. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone A) may be moved *into* Zone A from Zone B or from outside Zone B.
 - b. Things listed in Schedule 3 (under Zone B) may be moved *into* Zone B, from outside Zone B, but not from Zone A.

Schedule 1 Description of Controlled Area

The following areas are included in the Controlled Area and subject to this Notice:

Zone A

Controlled Area Zone A is the area within a 200 metre radius of a point in Clarence Road, Northcote Point, Auckland, as defined in the map in Schedule 2.

Zone B

Controlled Area Zone B is the area which has the boundaries listed below, and is defined in the map in Schedule 2.

Description of boundaries of Controlled Area (Zone B)

- (a) Beginning at the intersection of Exmouth Road and Sylvan Avenue in Northcote;
- (b) Proceeding south-east on Exmouth Road to the end of that road, and continuing in a straight line across the Northern Motorway (State Highway 1) to the Auckland harbour mean high water mark ("the shoreline");
- (c) Proceeding to a point 200m out to sea from the shoreline;
- (d) Turning south and proceeding in a southerly direction, following a line 200m out to sea from the shoreline at all times, towards a point 200m south of the shoreline of Stokes Point Reserve;
- (e) Turning north-west, and proceeding in a north-westerly direction in a straight line until level with a point 200m from the shoreline at the end of Rawene Road, Birkenhead;
- (f) Proceeding in a straight line into shore to the end of Rawene Road;
- (g) Proceeding in a northerly direction along Rawene Road, to the intersection with Hinemoa Street;
- (h) Turning north-west on Hinemoa Street and proceeding through the roundabout to Birkenhead Avenue;
- (i) Proceeding along Birkenhead Avenue in a northerly direction, to the intersection of Birkenhead Avenue and Pupuke Road;
- (j) Turning east on Pupuke Road and proceeding along Pupuke Road until the intersection with Raleigh Road;
- (k) Turning south-east onto Raleigh Road and proceeding along Raleigh Road to the roundabout;
- (l) Continuing straight through the roundabout on to Exmouth Road; and then
- (m) Continuing south-east along Exmouth Road to the intersection of Exmouth Road and Sylvan Avenue.

Specific Properties in Zone A

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of the Controlled Area Zone A, the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area Zone A.

Specific Properties in Zone B

Where a property is bisected by the boundary of Controlled Area Zone B, the entire property shall be included in the Controlled Area Zone B.

Schedule 3 – Things subject to Movement Controls

Zone A

1. **Zone A fruit and vegetables**, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables, wherever grown, except for:
 - a. leafy vegetables; and
 - b. root vegetables; and
 - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
2. Packaging materials associated with Zone A fruit and vegetables.
3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees, wherever grown.
4. Compost and green waste that contains Zone A fruit and vegetables.

Zone B

1. **Zone B fruit and vegetables**, meaning all whole fruit and vegetables grown inside Zone B, except for:
 - a. leafy vegetables; and
 - b. root vegetables; and
 - c. cooked, processed, preserved, dried, frozen and canned fruit.
2. Packaging materials associated with Zone B fruit and vegetables.
3. Soil and planting medium attached to, or in the vicinity of, fruit bearing trees grown inside Zone B.
4. Compost and green waste that contains Zone B fruit and vegetables.
