The guide brings all the principles of IPM together in one manual so that irrespective of the crop being grown there are IPM steps to follow.

The guide steps through the key principles of IPM and begins with a checklist to consider the key aspects of an IPM approach. From this checklist the reader is directed to specific chapters to find out more about the detailed aspects of IPM. Through each of the chapters the reader can access additional reading and related extension resources.
