	<p>How to use <i>Engytatus</i> with banker plants</p> <p>This video gives tips for using <i>Engytatus</i>, a native predator insect that can be used as a biological control for some pests common in greenhouse tomato plants.</p>
	<p>How to scout</p> <p>This video explains what good scouting in a greenhouse looks like and why it's important to do regular scouting as part of your IPM. You can use this video in conjunction with the written resource 'How to Scout'</p>
	<p>How to set up your sprayer</p> <p>This video has lots of tips for correctly setting up your sprayer for when physical modes of action are required for pest control. Use this in conjunction with the guides to the effect of chemicals on BCAs.</p>
